- 7. Assist in worship services and preaching as needed.
- 8. Build relationships with those in our congregation, church leadership and community.
- 9. Help guide people into discovering and using their gifts for ministry.
- 10. Share in the pastoral care and counseling ministries of Calvary including weddings and funerals.
- 11. Model servant-leadership inside and outside of the church.
